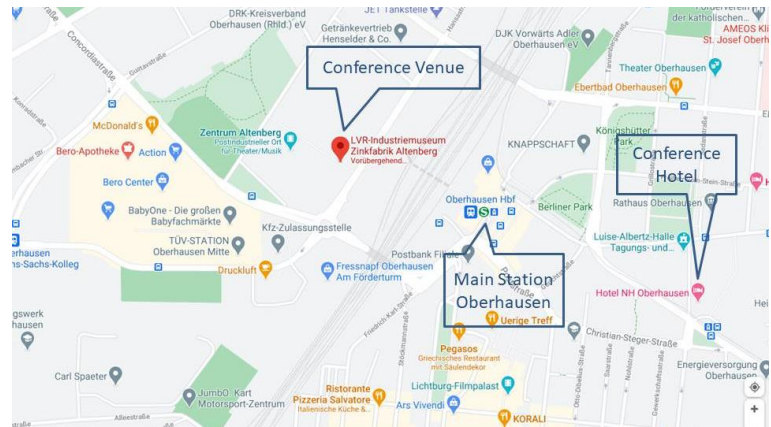
Oberhausen Main Station (in walking distance of the Museum and the NH Hotel) is connected via ICE (High Speed train)

Corona Regulations

Due to the Covid-19 regulations valid in Germany, we cannot accept registrations from people coming from Corona risk areas/countries. The list of countries is daily updated.

On site you need to observe Corona rules, you are obliged:

- Not to attend if you show or feel any symptoms of illness or disease
