

Saxony

- Mining started the 12th century
- Most important industrial region in Germany until 1945; also richest and most densely populated region of Germany
- Large variety of small and medium-sized companies; many world-market leaders
- Leipzig: oldest and most important trade fair place in the world
- Chemnitz: cradle of German engineering, "Saxon Manchester", highest industrial output
- Dresden: second highest industrial output


